Parties interested in participating in an internship with the United States Probation & Pretrial Services Office are required to upload the following documents to the Employment Application System (link provided below) and answer the pre-screening questions.

- Cover letter (two-page limit) answering the following questions:
 - What is your major and what do you hope to learn from your experience as an intern?
 - In what year are you in your program?
 - How many hours per week can you commit to working as an intern in our district?
 - How long (number of weeks, months, or semesters) can you commit to our program?
- A signed, complete <u>application</u> (AO-78 rev 5/24)
- Two letters of recommendation
- Unofficial transcripts (Official transcripts may be required for selected applicants)
