Questions & Answers

Design, Supply, and Installation of Glass Office Partitions

Q-Do we want to go with ceiling-to-floor dividers?

A-We would like the dividers to be consistent with those used in our other offices, which are not ceiling-to-floor.

Q-Can we use a column for the base of the four desks?

A-Yes, a column base is acceptable if required.

Q-Are we looking for a setup like the one in the example photo?

A-Yes, the example photo reflects the desired setup.

Q-Are we able to use the glass and finishes like those outside the old Deputy Suite (office reviewed during the pre-bid meeting)?

A-Yes, we would like to use the same or similar glass and finishes.

A-Do we want sliding doors?

A-Yes, sliding doors are preferred.

Q-Where will the power outlets be located?

A-Outlet locations have not yet been finalized. They will be determined after the proposed layouts are reviewed and office configurations are established.

Q-What are the dimensions of the desks to be accommodated in each office?

A-Specific desk dimensions have not been finalized. However, we would like to accommodate at least a minimum standard desk size (main surface -60-72" x return size - 48-60"x depth-24"). Final dimensions will depend on the proposed layouts and space planning.

Q-Is Plexiglass an acceptable option for this project?

A-The RFP specifies tempered safety glass meeting commercial safety standards as a basis of design. However, equivalent alternatives such as a plexiglass may be submitted for review, provided they meet applicable safety requirements and demonstrate comparable performance and durability.
